What is you get the following error message:

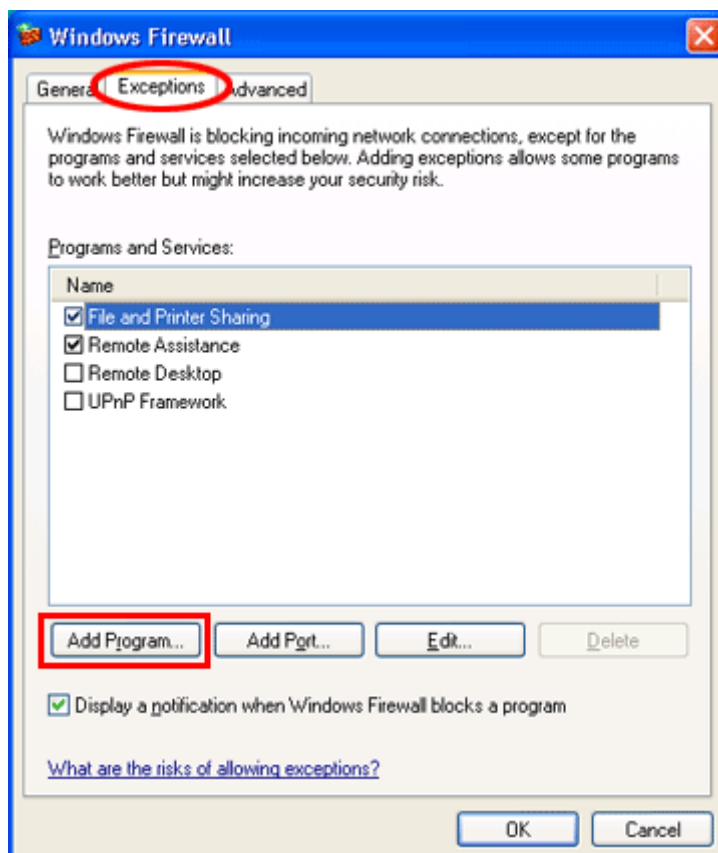


### Solution:

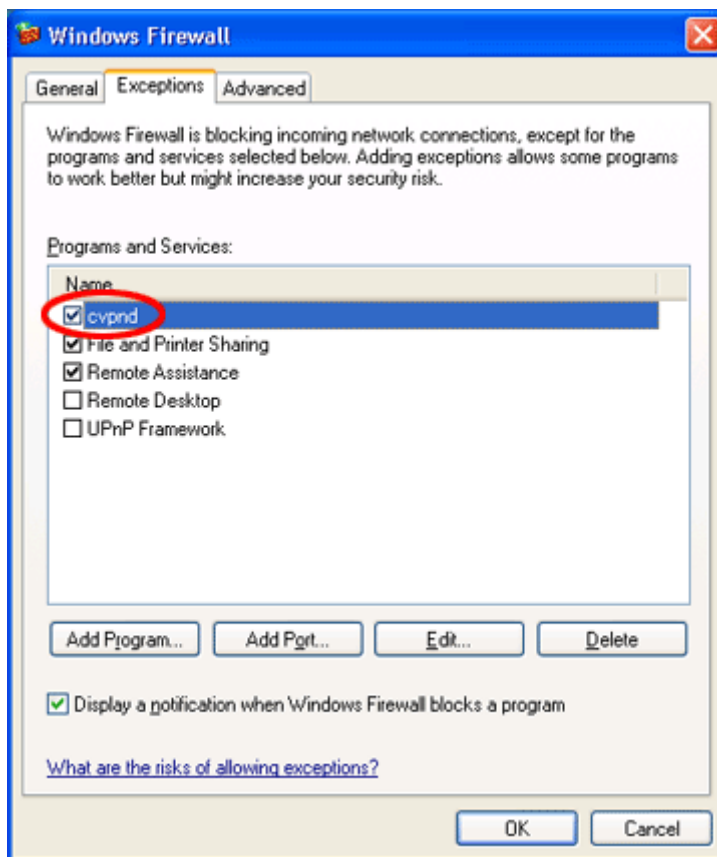
#### Configure Windows Firewall

This step **MUST** be completed for **ALL** Windows XP SP2 connections.

1. Select **Start > Control Panel**.
2. Using WinXP Category view, click **Network and Internet Connections** and then click **Windows Firewall**. The Windows Firewall dialog box displays.
3. Select the **Exceptions** tab and click **Add Program**.



4. Click **Browse** and locate the **cvpnd.exe** file.
  - By default, this file is located in the Program Files-Cisco Systems-VPN Client folder. If you chose to install the Cisco VPN Client in another directory, navigate to that location.
  - If your machine is not setup to display file extensions, the file name will display as cvpnd.
5. Select the **cvpnd.exe** file and click **Open**.
6. Click **OK**. The Exceptions tab redisplayes with cvpnd listed under Programs and Services.



7. Click **OK** to close the Windows Firewall window.
8. try reconnecting to the VPN.
